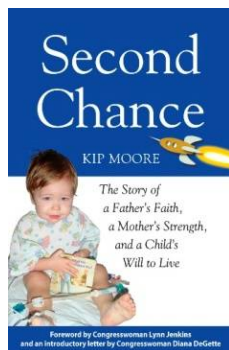


Food Safety Advocate
