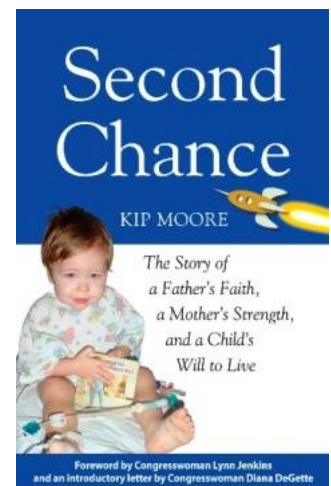

- What advice would you give other couples with critically ill children?
- Chance survived. Is he an unusual case? Have you talked to any parents who have been through similar ordeals?

- What is happening now in Congress to prevent this from happening to other families?
- Where can people purchase your book, and how can they contact you?
